

Vivace! Band Camp

Guidelines

- Parents are to drop off their child at the school after 8:30 a.m. and pick them up before 3:15 p.m. each day. No before or after camp child care is available.
- The daily schedule will be announced by the camp staff at the beginning of each day. Make sure to move quickly to each activity so that each can start on time. We want to get the most out of our rehearsal, master class, other activities and of course lunch and recreation time!
- Orderly and considerate behavior is expected at all times. No discipline problems will be tolerated (horseplay, practical jokes, disrespect to staff, etc). Students causing problems or disturbances will be subject to dismissal from the camp without a refund of the registration fee.
- Students are to remain with their group/instrument section at all times and must be only in camp designated areas of the school (music wing during rehearsals and master classes/gymnasium or outside field during recreation time)
- Instruments are not to be played anywhere in the school other than in full band rehearsal, master classes or sectionals.
- Students are expected to give full attention to every staff member while receiving instruction, both during rehearsals and also lunch and recreational activities.
- Students are to take extra care of the facilities in the music area. No student should play any instrument other than the one assigned to him/her. All students should take care of chairs and stands by sitting properly and not leaning on music stands. Percussionists are to take extra care in using auxiliary percussion equipment (bass drum, gong, suspended and crash cymbals, wood block, etc.)
- Keep rehearsal areas neat, orderly and picked up. Make sure lunch trash is placed in trash cans provided.
- If you should become ill, please let a staff member know immediately so that we can give you the proper attention.
- As we move about to rehearsals, master classes, lunch, recreation time and other activities, be a good reflection on the camp and your parents. Running, yelling and other inappropriate behaviors are totally out of place for the Vivace! Band Camp.
- Parents must notify camp staff members of any prescription drugs campers may have with them.
- In the event of an emergency, please call the camp director – Jay Hutcherson at 678-478-8098. If there is a problem with this number (cell phone reception) please call the school at 770-740-7090 and they will get the message to us.
- Please get to know the entire camp staff, not just the director and your master class instructor. We are here to help you have an educational and fun-filled week. Please let us know of any problem or issue that you may have and we will be ready to help. The more cooperative and friendly you are, the more we can be in return. **LET'S HAVE A GREAT CAMP!!!!**
